- Manage Agile Project Risks by Incremental Delivery, Minimum Viable Product (MVP), Minimum Business Increment (MBI), Timeboxing techniques
- Enable Agile Operating System: Co-Workers Mutual Support, Knowledge Transparency through collaboration technology

- Establish Transformation Governance Structure e.g. Agile, Scrum, Scrum of Scrums, hierarchical settings
