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Course Outline

Course objectives (specific learning goals)

- Understand the basic concepts, common applications, and ethical considerations of generative AI.
- Be able to use text-based AI (e.g., POE / DeepSeek) for travel planning, itinerary writing, and generating personal stories.
- Master image-generation tools (Midjourney, Nano Banana, etc.) to create everyday images and preserve memories.
- Learn to produce short social media videos (Reels / Shorts), from gathering assets and scripting to final editing.
- Be able to write and fine-tune effective prompts to achieve desired outputs across different tools.
- Learn to manage output files, copyright, and personal data concerns, and evaluate the quality of AI-generated content.

Learning outcomes

- Apply AI tools to handle everyday life-related tasks.
- Use generative AI to create simple images and short videos.
- Write effective prompts to accomplish common personal tasks.

Student assignments (examples)

- Generate a 3-day travel itinerary (including transportation, meals, attractions, and budget), and upload the final prompt and the model's response (as a text file).
- Use AI to generate a 300–500 word personal story or diary entry, and submit the original prompt plus a brief self-assessment (degree of style achievement).
- Generate three images related to a personal theme, and submit the prompts and reflections (including revision strategies).
- Produce a 15–60 second short video (Reels/Shorts) that integrates AI-generated images and a text script, and describe the production process and tools used.
